FIRST AID MEASURES



Eye contact	Remove contact lenses, irrigate copiously with clean, fresh water, holding the eyelids apart for at least 15 minutes and seek immediate medical advice and show the container or label .
Skin contact	Remove contaminated clothing and shoes. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water or use recognised skin cleanser. Do NOT use solvents or thinners.
Inhalation	Remove to fresh air. Keep person warm and at rest. If not breathing, if breathing is irregular or if respiratory arrest occurs, provide artificial respiration or oxygen by trained personnel.
Ingestion	Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. if swallowed, seek medical advice immediately and show the container or label. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Rinse mouth thoroughly with water. Keep person warm and at rest.

Storage
